Goal:

Students are taught in the classroom and in the vehicle by New York State accredited teachers licensed to provide a comprehensive introduction to their driving experience. The primary goal is to teach the safe, efficient operation of a motor vehicle and to develop the proper habits and attitudes needed for defensive driving. Besides the course hours, additional practice is highly recommended in order to bring a new driver to higher levels of driving performance.

Upon Completion:

Students who successfully complete the course will receive a student certificate of completion (MV-285), which includes an insurance premium reduction certificate. After receiving the MV-285 and passing the road test, a 17-year-old is eligible for a full, New York State senior license. A 16-year-old is issued a junior license with restrictions, which automatically turns into a senior license on their 17th birthday. Without completion of a driver's education program, a New York State senior license is not issued until the age of 18.

Eligibility:

Students must be 16 by February 15th, 2019 for the spring semester. All registered students must secure a NYS Learner's Permit or non-Driver ID card by April 1st, 2019. Please note that if a NYS Learner's Permit or Non-Driver ID card is not secured by provided date, the student will not be issued a certificate of completion (MV-285). *(For more information, please visit the DMV website: <http://www.dmv.ny.gov>)*

Course Information:

Students are required to attend sessions that consist of classroom instruction and driving instruction including observation with each student spending 6 hours behind the wheel. Attendance is mandatory for all enrolled students.

Absences/Make-Ups:

No more than 2 absences are permitted in either lecture or driving sessions. It is the student's responsibility to make arrangements with your lecture or driving instructor regarding make-ups.

Tuition/Refund:

Tuition is **\$500.00**, excluding textbooks, which cost **\$50.00**(optional). All forms of payment are accepted. Payments may be made by check, payable to **The Berkeley Carroll School**. Please include student's name and "Driver Education" on memo of check. All credit card payments will be charged by Berkeley Carroll either by completed attached form or by calling the business office. Tuition must be paid in full either at registration, or before program starts. If tuition is not paid in full by **February 19th, 2019** student will be withdrawn from the program. No refunds will be granted once classes begin. There will be no refunds for failure to complete the course. Tuition does not include fees paid to the Department of Motor Vehicles for obtaining a Learner's Permit or Driver's License. Tuition also does not include fees incurred for scheduling a Road Test and/or additional private lessons taken beyond the course requirement.

Registration:

All interested students must attend one of the registration/orientation days listed below. Payment and signed application (see back) must be brought to registration. At registration, the students will be able to select their choice of lecture/driving day and time. It is not mandatory, but please bring in a copy of proof of date of birth. If applicable, please bring in your permit.

Students must complete 6 hours of driving behind the wheel in order to complete necessary requirements to receive certificate of completion (MV-285). Please note: Additional driving practice outside of Driver Education is highly recommended. Parents and students should familiarize themselves with New York State driving laws and regulations. First driving session will be on Tuesday, February 19th, 2019.
